I N T R O D U C T I O N	<p>After announcing the topic, the teacher will write the name of the topic i.e. Triangle on the top of the blackboard with block letters and underline it with a coloured chalk.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>TRIANGLE</u></p>
D E V E L O P M E N T	<p>The Teacher will then discuss the main points very briefly and write the same on the blackboard by keeping all components of the skill in mind as –</p> <p><u>Definition of Triangle:</u> A triangle is a <u>plane figure</u> formed by <u>three non-parallel line segments</u>.</p> <p><u>Types of Triangle:</u> There are <u>three</u> types of triangle.</p> <p>a) <u>Scalene Triangle:</u> A triangle in which all the <u>three sides</u> are <u>unequal</u> in length is called a <u>scalene triangle</u>.</p> <p>b) <u>Isosceles Triangle:</u> A Triangle in which <u>two sides</u> are <u>equal</u> in length is called an <u>isosceles triangle</u>.</p> <p>c) <u>Equilateral Triangle:</u> A triangle in which all the <u>three sides</u> are <u>equal</u> in length is called an <u>equilateral triangle</u>.</p>
